• 127 Plaintiff Firms filing nationally, 17 filing in New York





Total Filings National Trends vs. New York State






NY has been #2 state for asbestos filings since 2017

- NYC 77-79% of NY State Total




2023 - 2024

- 60% of NY state total (2024)


Other NY Jurisdictions

National Trends | Filings by Disease



2024 Trend: Mesothelioma represent 50%, Lung Cancer represent 41% of all filings



2023 vs 2024 (point in time)

Mesothelioma increase of 2% (or hold steady)

Lung Cancer increase of 19%

Non-malignant decrease of 12%

Unknown decrease of 9%

Other Cancer increase of 15%



Disease Trends New York vs. Other States




NY makes up 14% of Mesothelioma and 13% of Lung Cancer claims filed nationally (in line with NY's % of total filings)


NY makes up 82% of the complaints without a disease filed nationally



Disease Trends | New York Jurisdictions (as of 12/1)









- Meso: 52% of total, up 15%
- LC: 44% of total, up 6%
- Unknown: 3% of filings, 9 YTD

- Meso: 42% of total, down 6%
- LC: 30% of total, down 5%
- Unknown: 26% of total, 46 YTD

National Trends | Talc Filings







- National filings have almost doubled since 2021
- Talc included on 18% of total filings (national)
- NY makes up 17% of national talc filings
- Talc included on 22% of NY (state) filings
- Talc included on 28% of NYC filings

Verdict Trends | Verdicts















- Wagner v. American Honda Motor Co. (\$600k)
 - 79-year-old, living mesothelioma
 - Verdict against Honda, but jury found AHM did NOT act with reckless disregard.
 - No punitive damages awarded.
 - 21 non-party entities on verdict sheet
- Cardillo v. Chanel Inc. et al (\$0)
 - 80-year-old, deceased mesothelioma
 - Unanimously found for defendant American International Inc. (talc supplier)
- No 2024 NY Verdicts outside of NYCAL
