 - Ability to move jurisdiction within the State
 - Diversity of Parties

Worker's Compensation

- Location of where accident took place
- Location of where injured worker was hired
- Principal business location of the employer

Exclusive Remedies



Will Differ from State to State depending on jurisdiction

Ability to move for summary judgement or dismissal

Elements Needed to Prove Contribution

- Contribution is a principal of liability sharing
- In a negligence claim, the elements needed to prove another defendant's liability are
 - Duty
 - Breach
 - Causation
 - Damages
- However, in construction claims, the duty owed to other defendants is created by contract

RAPID RESPONSE – LIABILITY



- Benefits of OSHA Certification
 - Access to construction sites
 - Knowledge of safety standards, common OSHA violations, instrumentalities involved
- Purpose
 - Preservation of physical evidence
 - Gathering documents critical to liability and risk transfer
 - Taking statements before witnesses "disappear"
- Value Added to Defense/Claims Management
 - Experts and investigators are involved EARLY
 - Work product and attorney-client privileges triggered
 - Realistic liability picture on Day 1
 - Evidence procured to pursue risk transfer as soon as possible
 - Potential to head off litigation through pre-suit resolution
 - Prevention of spoliation charges in litigation
