





How Immunotherapy Is Used to Treat Cancer



Immunotherapy is treatment that uses certain parts of a person's immune system to fight diseases such as cancer. This can be done in a couple of ways:

- Stimulating, or boosting, the natural defenses of your immune system so it works harder or smarter to find and attack cancer cells
- Making substances in a lab that are just like immune system components and using them to help restore or improve how your immune system works to find and attack cancer cells

In the last few decades immunotherapy has become an important part of treating some types of cancer. New immunotherapy treatments are being tested and approved, and new ways of working with the immune system are being discovered at a very fast pace.




The first FDA-approved immunotherapy treatment—Bacillus Calmette-Guérin cancer vaccine—was for bladder cancer in 1990.







































Dr. Testa Conceded Genetics Alone Can Cause Mesothelioma

- + Dr. Testa, in deposition, testified:
 - 4 You agree that genetics alone can cause
 - 5 mesothelioma independent of environmental factors?
 - 6 A I believe it's possible in rare cases.
- + Dr. Testa also acknowledged that there are in fact genetically linked spontaneous cancers:

Testa Testimony (Spontaneous Mesothelimoas)

- + Q: And in that paper it indicates that experimental mouse models have allowed researchers, like you, to show the inactivation of single genes or combinations of specific genes such as BAP1, TSE1, TP53, CDKN2A, and/or NF2 and spontaneously initiate or cause and drive mesothelioma tumorigenesis without asbestos exposure, right?

Adults 70 kg 38 trillion cells) "Our bodies are made up of trillions of cells, which must work together to keep us healthy. Our cells need to be able to divide to make new cells to help the body grow, or to replace cells that have died. At the same time, cell growth and division need to be controlled, so the cells don't grow too much and crowd out the cells around them."

"It may be helpful to think of a cell as a car. For it to work properly, there need to be ways to control how fast it goes — that is, ways to speed up cell growth and division if it's needed (like a gas pedal), and ways to keep this growth under control or slow it down (like a brake pedal). There also need to be ways to fix parts of the car if they break down."

Multi-Celled Organisms like Humans

Replenishment Stem cells Muscle cells Gut cells Liver cells Blood cells. Heart cells Nerve cells

"The stem cells, which have the capability to become several cell types, consistently divide to replenish the loss of old cells. Different cell types have various turnover rates. For example, cells that protect the inner surface of our stomach and gut need to change every 2-5 days. Our skin cells need to be replenished every other week. Liver cells can work for a year before retirement. About 1-10% of heart muscle cells renew every year. However, nerve cells in the brain and lens cells in the eyes have to work for the entire lifetime."



What Does This mean For Us?

+ The genetic issue presents an ongoing dynamic and not a latent condtion.



Egg Shell Plaintiff

- + A defendant takes a plaintiff "as they find them" and is responsible for all damages, resulting from conduct "Even though, because of the plaintiff, preexisting frailty of health, they proved to be more severe than they would have been in a "normal person".
- + Elderly Plaintiff



An Issue of Causation

- + The Genetic issue presents a dynamic process that is occurring independently from alleged somatic (i.e. environmental or "exposure") potential causes.
- + Did the conduct of the defendant or defendants cause ("but for" or "substantial contributing factor") the cancer to occur?



Spectrum of Cause

- + Heavy and lengthy occupational exposure -> Employment/paraoccupational -> Take Home -> Questionable or Unknown
- + Genetic issue? Identified? Treatment? Cancer syndrome in individuals or families.
- + This issue is redefining our knowledge in a significant way and is fundamental to cancer treatment. It is not going away.






